# California MAP Initiative

Maximize CPL for Veterans so they receive the credits they have earned from their Joint Services Transcript (JST), save time and avoid repeat study, validate their course work and work experience from their MOS/RATE while in service, and achieve extended educational and career goals with existing benefits and financial aid.



# What is Credit for Prior Learning (CPL)

Prior Learning Assessment (PLA) or Credit for Prior Learning (CPL) is college credit awarded for validated college-level skills and knowledge gained outside of a college classroom. Students' knowledge and skills might be gained through experiences such as:

- Military Training (JST Credit Recommendations)
- Industry Certifications and Licenses
- Standardized Exams (DLPT, AP, IB, CLEP, etc.)
- Portfolio Review
- Credit by Exam



# Non-Military CPL our Veterans May Have

- •Examinations: Credit by Exam, CLEP, AP, IB
- Industry Credentials and Licensures
- •Experiential Learning: Portfolios, Apprenticeship, etc.
- Noncredit to Credit
- •High School Course to College Course Articulations



- •#1 motivator to join military is higher education.<sup>14</sup>
- •53% overall cite education as primary motivation;
- •62% for African Americans.<sup>15</sup>
- •Only 36 months GI Bill Benefits for 48–66-month degree.

Barriers to completing educational goals:

- Finances (56%)
- Family obligations (28%)
- GI Bill benefits expire before completion (25%)
- Disability and wellness (23%)
- Job and school conflict (22%)



- 44% have service-connected disability.
   47% of those have disability rating >60%.<sup>17</sup>
- Disabilities associated with psychological distress (e.g., depression, PTSD, and stress associated with finances).<sup>18</sup>
- These issues add to transition stress.

- 45,000 veterans and active-duty committed suicide over the past six years--more than 20 per day.<sup>19</sup>
- Strong link between transition stress and suicide rate.<sup>20</sup>
- Suicide hazard 2.5 times higher within first year of separation.<sup>21,22</sup>

## Fewer years of education = higher suicide hazard when compared to those with a Bachelor's.<sup>21</sup>

Easing transition stress by offering CPL and VRC services can significantly reduce barriers, display cultural understanding of military students, maximize GI Bill and Financial Aid, and force your Institution of Higher Learning (IHL) to engage both local military installations and regional industries.

# Joint Services Transcript (JST)

A Joint Services Transcript (JST) is an academically accepted document provided by the Department of Defense (DOD) that has been approved by the American Council on Education (ACE) to validate a service members military course completions, military occupations, college level test scores and other learning experiences.

- Provided to service members (Veteran, Active Duty, Reservists) for the following branches: Army, Marine Corps, Navy, and Coast Guard.
- Accepted by more than 2,300 colleges and universities.
- Over 5,600 Credit Recommendations from ACE.
- Free of charge (98% via electronic vs 2% via paper).

# Each JST Includes the Following:

- Personal service member information.
- Military course completions full descriptions and credit recommendations.
- Military occupations full descriptions, skill levels and credit recommendations.
- College level test score CLEP, DSST and NCPACE.
- Other learning experiences additional completed courses and completions that have not been evaluated by ACE for college credit.
- Complete summary page.
- Education completions: Degrees, Certifications, Licensures, and Apprenticeships (if applicable).
- Other academic course completions (if applicable).

#### MILITARY ARTICULATION PLATFORM

The most thorough method is to upload a copy of your Joint Services Transcript (JST)



If you do not have your Joint Services Transcript (JST), you may download your JST from the DOD Website by Clicking here.

Another quick (but less thorough) method is to enter the MOS(s) or Rating(s) listed in your DD214. You may also enter ACE ID(s), which refer to specific military courses listed in your JST.
