# FY 2024 CoC Program Registration: CoC Review Registration Step - Now Open

**This message only applies to Continuums of Care (CoC) Collaborative Applicants.**

The FY 2024 Registration **CoC Review Step is Now Open** in [e-snaps](#) for Collaborative Applicants to review HUD's assessment and either agree or disagree with the determination.

**The CoC Review Submission Due Date is 4/30/2024 by 5:00 PM EDT.**

## Who must complete this step?

Collaborative Applicants who requested Unified Funding Agency (UFA) designation must access the CoC Review step in [e-snaps](#), review HUD's determination, and either accept or dispute.

## Who may complete the step, but are not required to?

All Collaborative Applicants are advised to review the CoC Review step in [e-snaps](#), but all aren't required to submit their CoC Review.

- If your CoC's Collaborative Applicant submitted the FY 2024 CoC Program Registration and did not request UFA designation, you can review and approve or dispute HUD's decision, but you are not required to complete this final step unless you dispute HUD's decision. HUD will move the CoC Review registration step forward for all non-UFA designated CoCs on April 30, 2024.
- If your CoC's Collaborative Applicant did not submit the registration forms in [e-snaps](#), HUD moved your CoC's registration forward on your behalf in accordance with Section V.A. of the [CPD-22-02: CoC Program Registration Notice](#). You may review your CoC's registration during the CoC Review Step; but you are not required to complete the CoC Review step unless you dispute HUD's decision. HUD will move forward the CoC Review registration step for all non-UFA designated CoCs that have not been completed on April 30, 2024.

All CoC's that HUD moves forward will have access to the CoC Consolidated Application

later this year when the FY 2024 CoC Program Competition opens.

### How to access the CoC Review step?

Collaborative Applicants can access *e-snaps* at <https://esnaps.hud.gov/grantium/> to review HUD’s determination and either agree and submit, at which point the CoC registration is final, or disagree and submit, at which point the registration will be returned to HUD for one final review and then returned to the Collaborative Applicant for final approval.

### CoC Review Step Instructions

- For instructions on submitting your agreement or disagreement with HUD’s Registration assessment during the CoC Review Step, please review the [Registration Guide](#) posted on the [CoC Program Competitions](#) Page on the [HUD.gov](#) website.
- If you submit your agreement with the Collaborative Applicant designation and the Geographic Area(s) listed, your registration is final. You will have access to the CoC Consolidated Application once it becomes available later this year.
- **Collaborative Applicants only have one opportunity to dispute HUD’s determination.** If you indicate that you disagree with the Collaborative Applicant designation and/or the Geographic Area(s) selected during CoC Review, the registrations forms will be returned to HUD for one final review once you submit the CoC Review in *e-snaps*.
  - HUD will review the registration one final time and consider the Collaborative Applicant’s proposed changes.
  - HUD will notify you via e-mail that a final determination has been made. You must log into *e-snaps* to access the *CoC Review HUD Final Decision* step and select “Submit.”
  - If you agree during this step and submit your approval in *e-snaps*, HUD will provide access to the CoC Consolidated Application when the FY 2024 CoC Program Competition opens later this year.
  - If you disagree during this step, the *e-snaps* system will generate a rejection letter and you will not have access to the CoC Consolidated Application when the FY 2024 CoC Program Competition opens.
